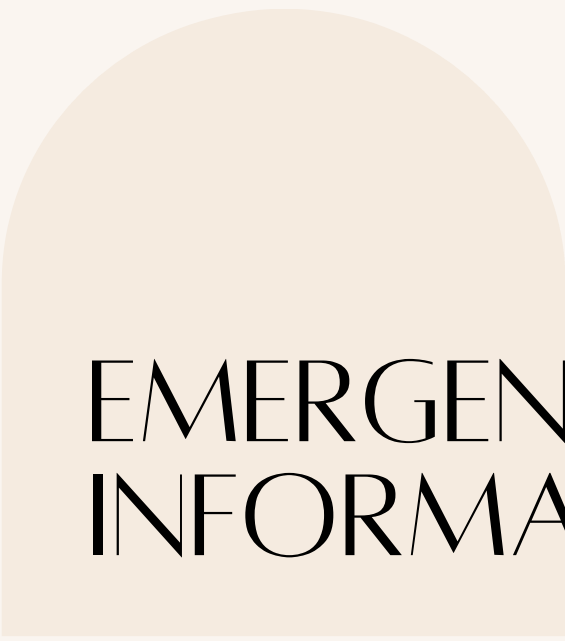

How to get there?

You have 3 options:

1. Renting a car at the airport

This is the best option because it will give you the freedom to explore the island. There is a lot to see on Tenerife and, despite its small size, it offers very diverse views and lots of attractive locations. Car rental is much cheaper here than on the mainland. Based on our experience we can recommend 2 rental companies that offer not only good prices, but also full insurance included and do not charge a deposit. Booking in advance will usually allow you to get best rates, and due to no cancellation fee we really encourage you to do so. These companies are:

a. Autoreisen (<https://www.autoreisen.com/car-hire/car-hire.php>)

b. Cicar (<https://www.cicar.com/en>)

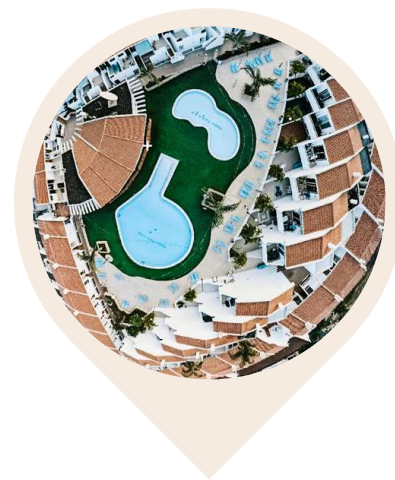
Important: if the above rental companies do not have cars available, let us know. Maybe we'll be able to help. And we don't recommend renting through search engines like rentalcars.

2. Taxi

It will cost about 30 Eur one way. The stopover is at the airport. However, during the season you can expect a long queue. Recently, Uber has started to operate on the island, but it does not constitute significant competition for taxis, because only premium buses and cars are available with significantly higher prices than the official local taxis.

3. Bus

Unfortunately there is no direct connection to our complex. There is a fast bus from the airport to Costa Adeje station. Here you'll have to change to another bus. With suitcases and children, it's not not necessarily the most convenient option. Still it's possible.

How to get there?

If you choose to rent a car, you drive from the airport along the TF-1 highway for approximately 20 minutes. Then take SALIDA 74 highway exit, just after you pass the SIAM PARK.

WHAT'S NEXT?

First, you should drive as close to the apartment as possible in order to avoid having to carry your suitcases.

Therefore it is best to go directly to the RECEPTION of MALIBU PARK HOTEL.

Please inform in the reception, that you have booked apt no 3007, identify yourself and you will get a key and the entrance card (10 eur deposit) and start your vacation :)

The apt is on the 3rd floor next to the pool.

Where to park?

If you don't find a place for you in the complex area (small parking in front of the reception), then please look for a place in the street or park at the large parking on the Avda. Austria.

Just back to Avda Austria, turn left and you will find the entrance to the parking in front of Doppiozero restaurant.

Directly by Doppiozero you can ENTER Malibu Park complex and use A LIFT(3th floor), so you do not have to go back to the reception.

Teide volcano

· The highest mountain in Spain – entry to the very top from the upper cable car station is possible only after prior online registration. The trip by car is also very exciting.



Masca

· A village in the mountains with the possibility of walking through a gorge to the ocean (4 h) – prior res.. By car – access is via a very narrow and winding road. Extremely beautiful views.



Los Gigantes

a tour of the island from the west – very imposant cliffs.



Anaga Montains

· Beautiful views, various trekking routes, from the simplest one that you can easily take with children (approx. 2km – el sendero de los sentidos – route of the senses) through 10km routes through laurel forests, wild beaches, to full-day trips.



La Laguna

San Cristobal de La Laguna, ancient capital of Canary Island was declared as a World Herritage Site by UNESCO in 1999. Nothern city, 550 m above sea level – take your jacket when visiting in wintertime.

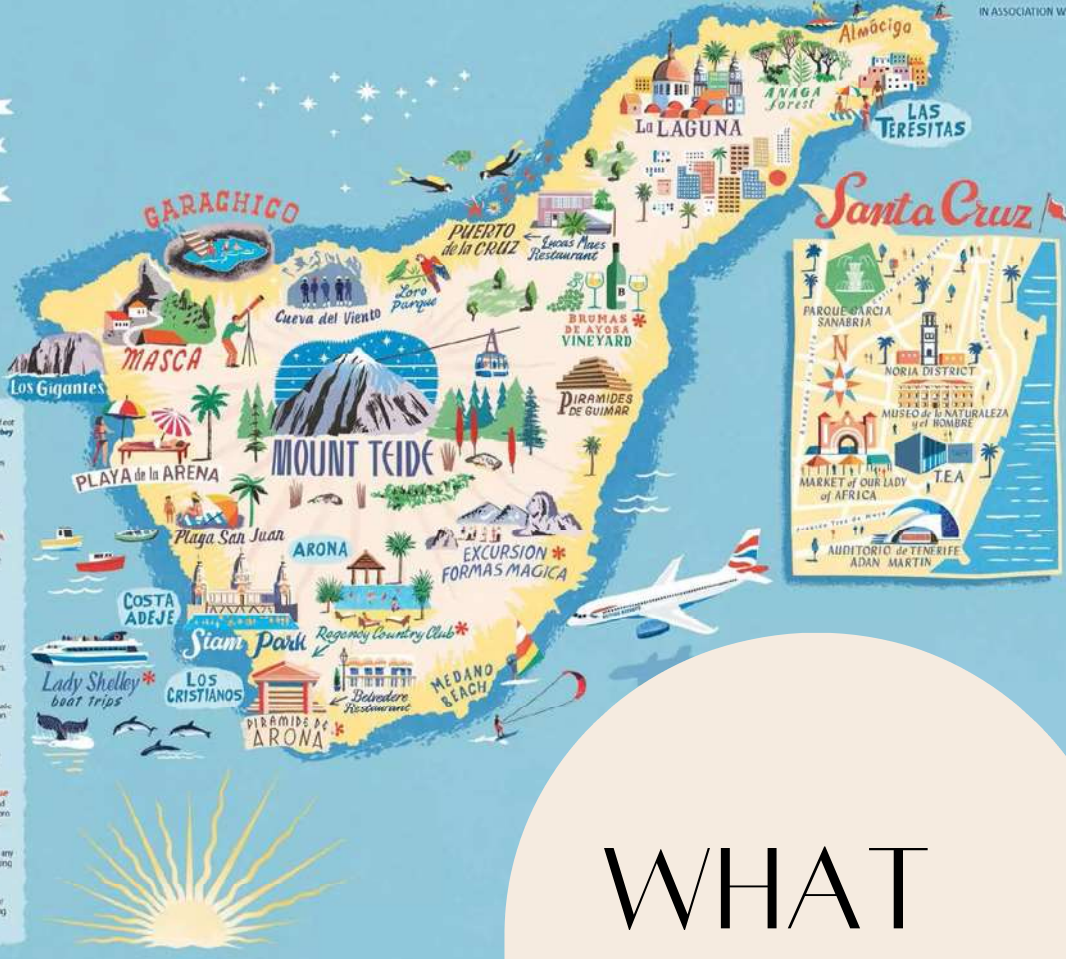

- Almôcigo**
Remote watersport spot, which is great even for Interp surfers who will have the day's brilliant breaks to themselves.
- Anaga Forest Rural Park**
Tuckled away in the Anaga mountain range in the north-east, this humid forest is home to rare Laurisilva, or laurel forests. If you love nature, it's a must.
- Arana/Costa Beach**

WHAT TO SEE MORE?

Aqualand

Another water park with slides perfect also for small children. Dolphin shows included and this just few steps of our apartment.

Jungle Park

Beautiful green ZOO with shows of wild birds and other animals (you can buy the combined ticket with Aqualand) - 10 minutes by car. It is important to check the hours of bird shows when planning your visit - this is the flagship show of this park.

Monkey Park

A park where you can see various monkeys, but also pet many guinea pigs, feed a lemur, and spend time with geckos. Rather for younger children. 10 minutes by car from us.

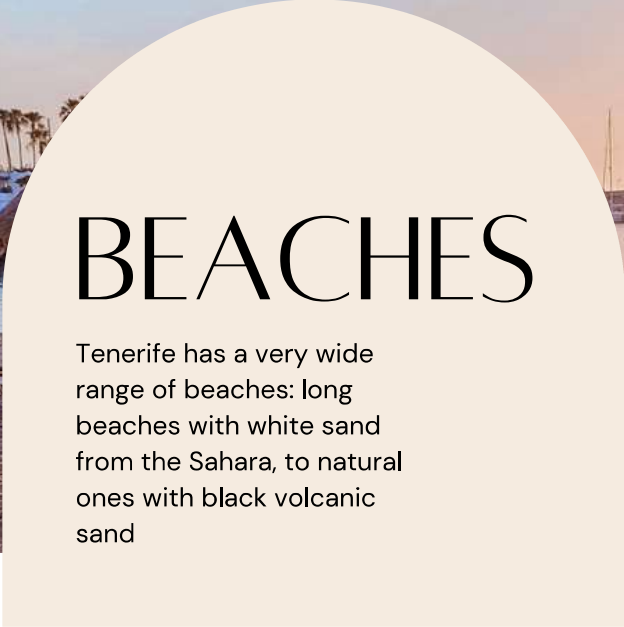
Botanical Garden

BEACHES

Tenerife has a very wide range of beaches: long beaches with white sand from the Sahara, to natural ones with black volcanic sand



Playa del Duque, 3,5 km from the apt

Must see beach.

The most known beach in the south with sand and beautiful blue color of the sea.

There are many 5-star hotels in the area with spa facilities. A breath of luxury. Big waves on its left side, besides the cliffs. Showers and sunbeds available.

Playa de La Pinta, 1,2 km from the apt

Playa La Pinta is a beach in Puerto Colon with mixed sand. This is a lovely, smaller beach with loungers, umbrellas and a breakwater to protect you from the big waves, making this beach perfect for small children. This part is much cheaper than the upscale part of Playa del Duque and quieter than Playa de las Americas. Playa La Pinta is perfect for families because it is peaceful and even has an inflatable playground on the ocean. Lifeguards are on site every day all year round. Showers available.

Playa Torviscas, 2 km from the apt.

Great beach. This beach is connected to Playa Fanabe, separated only by a breakwater. Sunbeds are available for hire. They are hired from the bar at the back of the beach that offer table service for food and drink. Showers available.

Las Vistas, 5 km from the apt.

Playa Las Vistas is considered the most beautiful beach in Los Cristianos and the only one with the Blue Flag distinction. With the man made sand, so it's a white sand beach not natural black. Clean. Lots of shops around, very touristic.

Playa Fanabe, 2,5 km from the apt

Playa de Fanabe is one of the busiest and most popular beaches in Tenerife and the largest on the Costa Adeje. Located in the south of the island, it is connected by a promenade to neighboring Puerto Colon and Playa del Duque. From the bars on the promenade you can enjoy spectacular views of the sunset and the neighboring island of La Gomera while sipping an evening drink

Playa de Benijo, 105 km from the apt.

Considered one of the most spectacular beaches in Tenerife, Playa Benijo is an absolute must-see to fully appreciate the beauty of the island. With its giant rocks scattered along the coast and fine dark sand, Benijo beach is the jewel in the crown of Tenerife in the north, a place of wonder and fear, due to the power of the ocean in these parts.

Playa de las Teresitas, 80km from the apt

Situated in the north, in the small village of San Andres, Playa de las Teresitas is one of the most popular and spectacular beaches in Tenerife. Because it is so close to the capital, it is definitely considered the best beach in Santa Cruz de Tenerife. The fine golden sand was brought here from Africa, which gives such an impression that many consider it the most beautiful beach in Tenerife. You will definitely see it in many photographs and many postcards
